

## SHIPYARD AND MARINA POTENTIAL RISKS

### All areas

<b>Potential risk</b>	<b>Pedestrian risks</b>
<b>Prevention measures</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Always proceed with the car at walking pace, respecting the signs. Pedestrians must use the appropriate lane delimited by the horizontal blue stripe.</i></li> <li>• <i>Respect the signs present on site.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Potential risk</b>	<b>Falling from stairs</b>
<b>Prevention measures</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Be very careful when carrying objects. Do not carry items that require both hands or prevent you from seeing steps.</i></li> <li>• <i>Help yourself with the handrails.</i></li> <li>• <i>Do not leave or deposit objects on the steps or landings.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Potential risk</b>	<b>Slip</b>
<b>Prevention measures</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Use shoes suitable for walking on site (no slippers, open shoes, etc.).</i></li> <li>• <i>Avoid transiting in wet areas.</i></li> <li>• <i>Respect the access prohibitions present on site.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Potential risk</b>	<b>Fire</b>
<b>Prevention measures</b>	<i>In the event of an emergency, remain calm and act quickly, however avoiding any behavior that could cause panic or hinder exodus. In the event of an evacuation, immediately suspend what you are doing, avoiding creating risk situations and go quickly and according to the shortest route to the assembly point indicated in the plans posted on site. At the assembly point, the emergency coordinator will carry out the roll call of the personnel.</i>
<b>Potential risk</b>	<b>Impact with objects</b>
<b>Prevention measures</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Obligation to wear a safety helmet.</i></li> <li>• <i>Obligation to wear safety shoes.</i></li> <li>• <i>Observe and respect the signs present on site.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Potential risk</b>	<b>Suspended loads</b>
<b>Prevention measures</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Do not stand under suspended loads.</i></li> <li>• <i>Do not pass under suspended loads and always wear a helmet.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Potential risk</b>	<b>Working vehicles moving</b>
<b>Prevention measures</b>	<i>The presence of people in the working area of mechanical means can cause serious injuries, even death. Those who necessarily find themselves near the machines must wear clearly visible clothing (preferably orange or red) or highly visible in the event of evening or night work. If it is necessary to approach the car, you must first make yourself visible to the driver by calling his attention from a safe position (never shouting from behind the silhouette of the vehicle). Subsequently, after having been sighted by the operator, wait for the machine to stop and, with the prior consent of the driver, only at this point approach the cab to communicate with the operator himself.</i>
<b>Potential risk</b>	<b>Other risks</b>
	<i>In the event of control and/or verification of maintenance, hauling, launching and storage activities carried out on the vessel, scrupulously follow the instructions received from Sudcantieri personnel, including any use of PPE that may become necessary.</i>

<b>Prevention measures</b>	<i>Wait for the gate to open completely</i>

**Driveway entrance, parking area**

<b>Potential risk</b>	<b>Car impact</b>
<b>Prevention measures</b>	<i>Follow the road signs. Signal with an acoustic signal only if strictly necessary. Keep a safe distance from other cars</i>
