Sudcantieri Marina to increase berthing for 25m to 60m (82ft-196.8ft) superyachts

Naples-based marina Sudcantieri has expanded its berthing facilities to accommodate superyachts from 25m-60m (82ft-196.8ft) in length.

Better known as the 'Marina di Maglietta', tourist berths are now being prepared in readiness for the America's Cup World Series, of which the first instalment in 2013 is to be held in Naples from April 7-15.

Overlooking the islands of Ischia and Procida, and just few miles from Capri, Sudcantieri mooring facilities are available for 200 boats up to 65m (213.2ft).

Besides berthing, Sudcantieri provides maintenance and a shipyard facility equipped with an 80 ton travel lift.
